

## Proposed Changes for 2023

### 1. PRESIDENT'S CUP TOURNAMENT:

- a. This 2- 18-hole rounds of Medal Play tournament has traditionally been played over a 6-week period. The WSC is proposing that the tournament be played either over 2 weekends. (June 24 & 25 and July 8 & 9) **OR** 2 consecutive days
- b. Members who participate would play their 2 rounds over the 2 specified weekends. You can play both rounds during only one weekend, or you can split your rounds over 2 weekends.
- c. This proposed changed was initiated due to the fact that only 8 members signed up to play the President's Cup in 2022, 4 of the members did not complete their rounds, leaving only 4 members.
- d. The feeling is that when you have 6 weeks to play the rounds, you think you have plenty of time, and then you wait until the end and then decide you can't complete the rounds.
- e. The other question is regarding the rule that you have to play your rounds with a FEMALE member. What is the reason you can't play with any member?

### 2. SENIORS/LEGENDS TOURNAMENT:

- a. Traditionally played over 6 weeks
- b. WSC proposing to decrease to play over 5 weeks.

3. The VSWGGA State Day @ PPCC is on **Wednesday**, July 5 this year. There will be **NO** organized Ladies golf that evening as the WSC members will be playing the State Day Tournament.

### 4. WEEKEND TOURNAMENTS:

- a. WSC proposes that weekend tournaments be 3 days: Friday – Saturday – Sunday. Not 4 days. **Drop Monday.**
- b. Of the 14 weekend tournaments in 2022, the average was 12 members that played in these weekend tournaments, and 6 times, ONE person played on Monday, one Monday 3 played, and 6 Mondays ,NO person played.
- c. On Monday, cards must be in and scores posted to GHIN by 12 Noon.
- d. Anyone who has served on the WSC knows the amount of work that goes into tallying and checking scores and compiling results. The committee would like to be able to meet on Monday afternoons to complete this.

### 5. RINGERS:

- a. Format will change this year.
- b. You will need to choose which tee box you will be playing from...RED, RED/YELLOW, or YELLOW...for the season. Example: If you normally play from the RED tees.....but for some reason you choose to play a round from the RED/YELLOW tees.....you can **NOT** use/post your scores from the RED/YELLOW tees on the Ringers Spreadsheet. This is for consistency and fairness.
- c. Score cards will not be issued by the WSC. Once members are signed up, participants names will go on a spreadsheet on the back bulletin board. Members will post their BEST Hole by Hole scores there.
- d. Participating members will be responsible for posting their scores.
